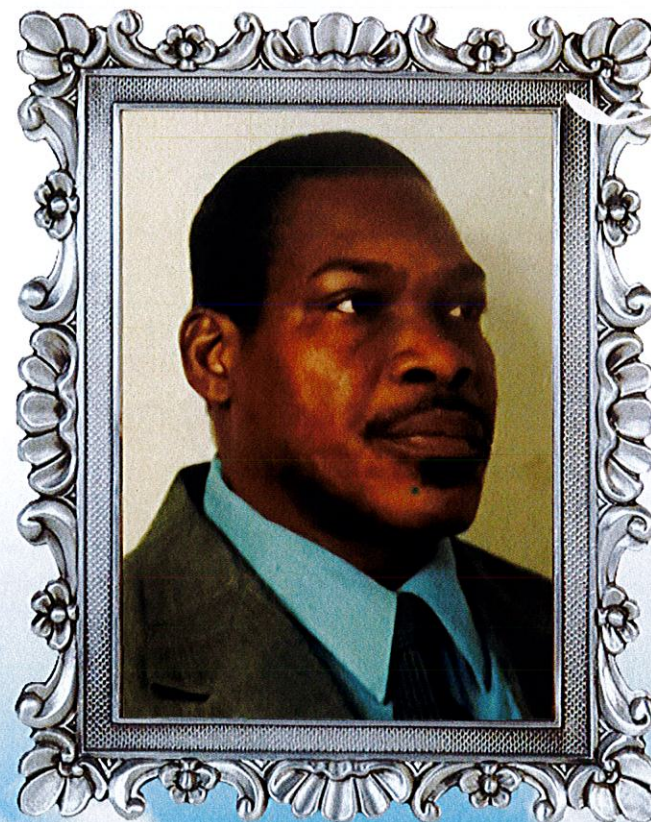

Erick Jean was preceded in death by his parents Edmond Jean and Francoise Pierre Jean and his brothers Franzy Jean and Fritzner Jean.



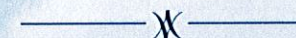
