

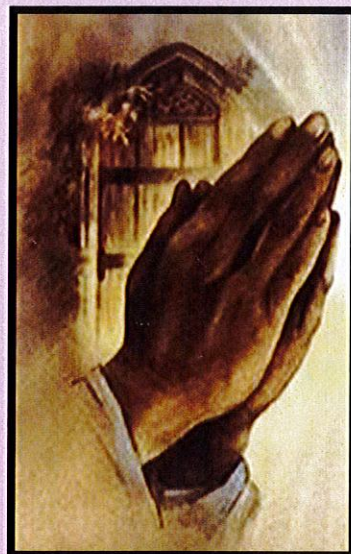
Acknowledgement
