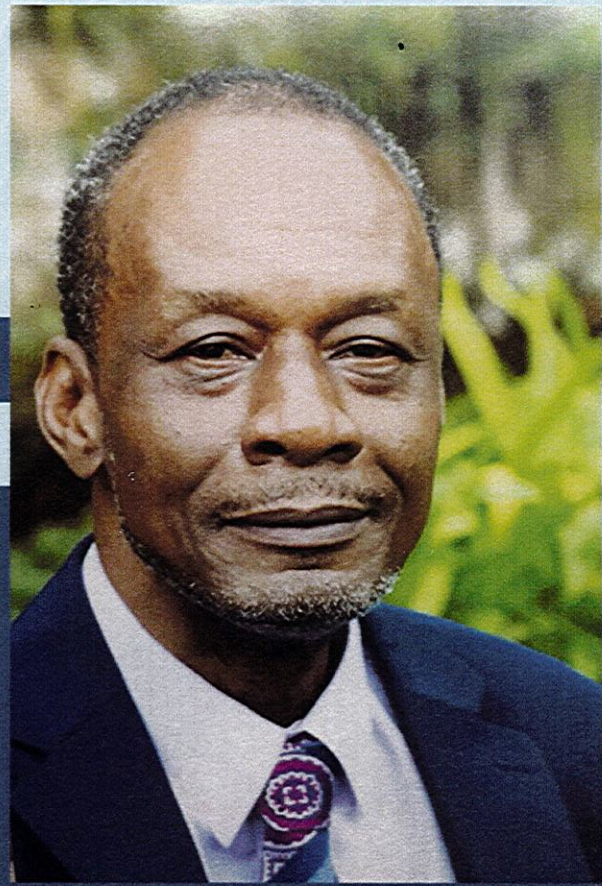
Take Me To The King.
